



June 2016:

In June, daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Overnight lows remained below normal for the month. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were below 2014 and 2015 values at Colchester, between 2014 and 2015 values at Kingsville and above 2014 and 2015 values at Cedar Springs. June rainfall averaged 35 % of normal across the appellation. One to two rainfall events of less than 18 mm was typical for the month.

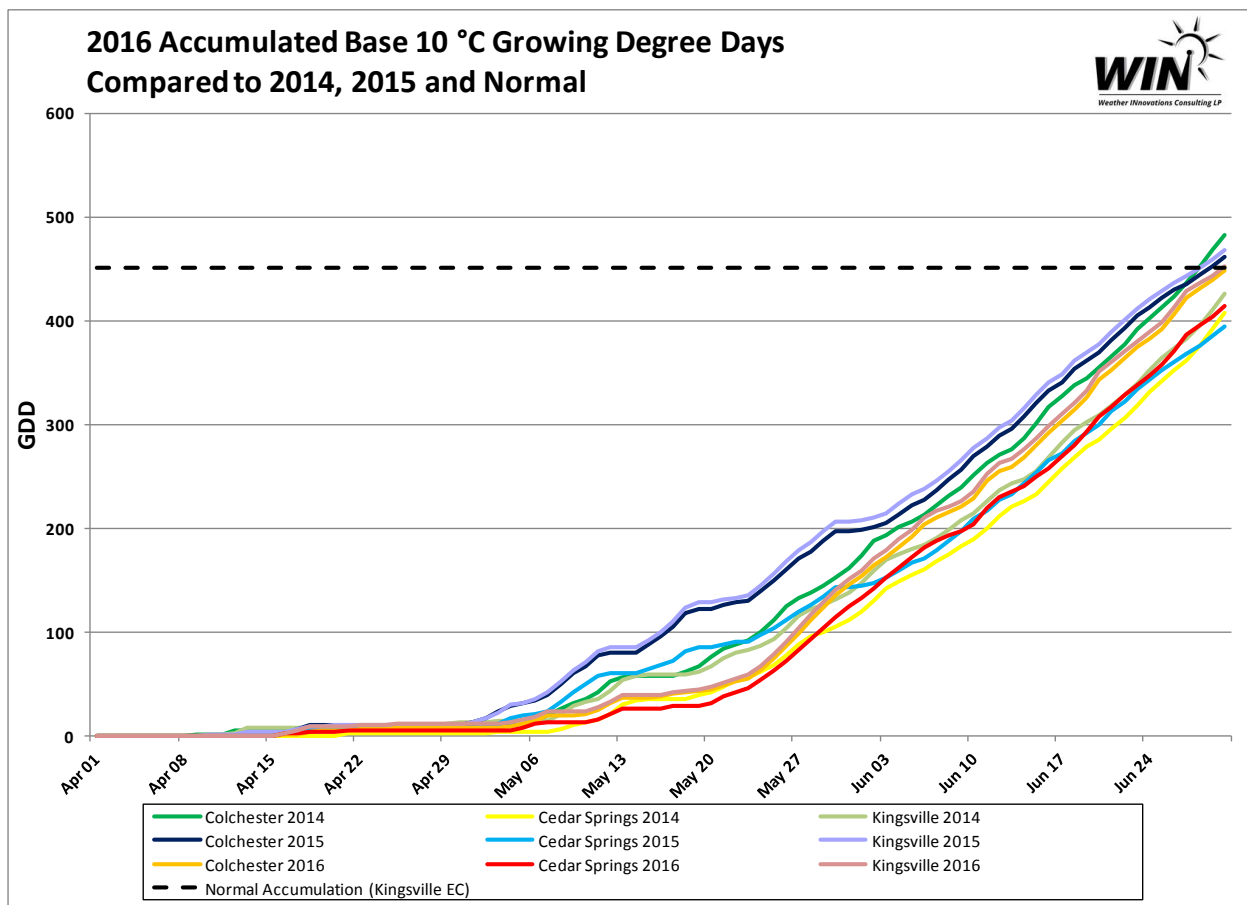


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

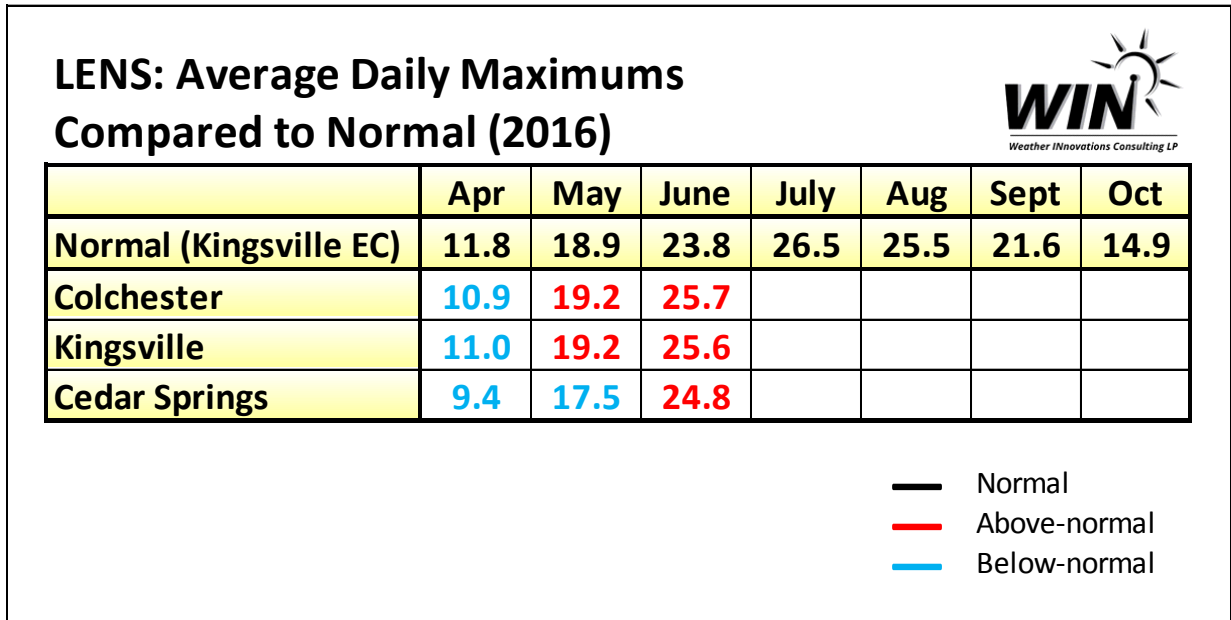


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

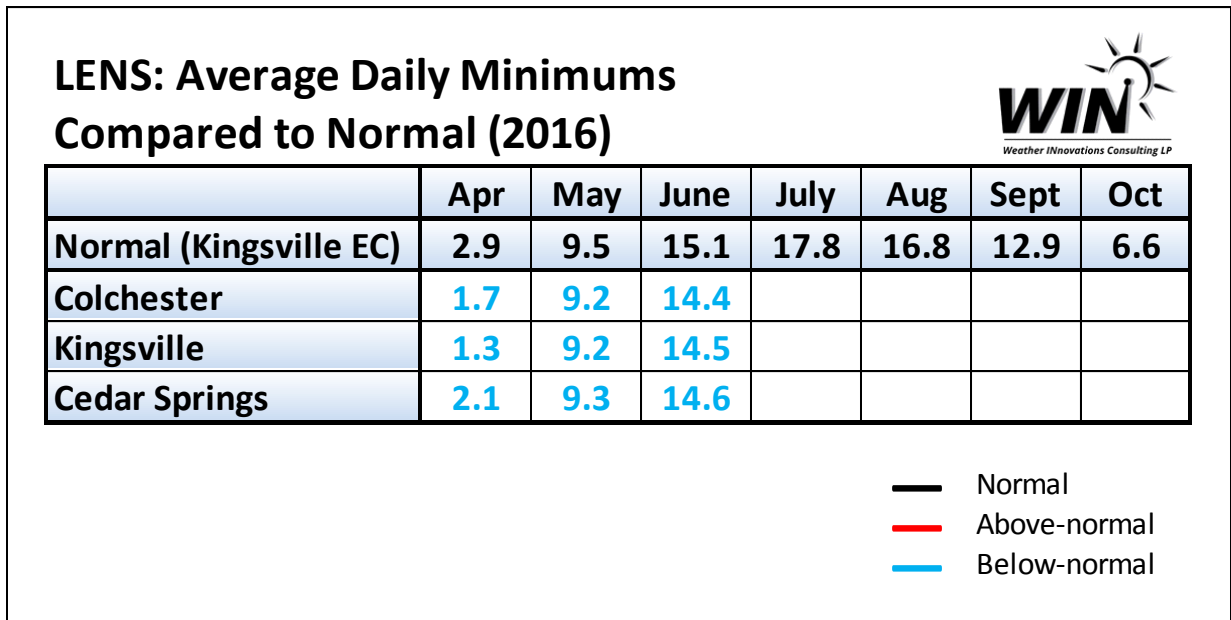


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

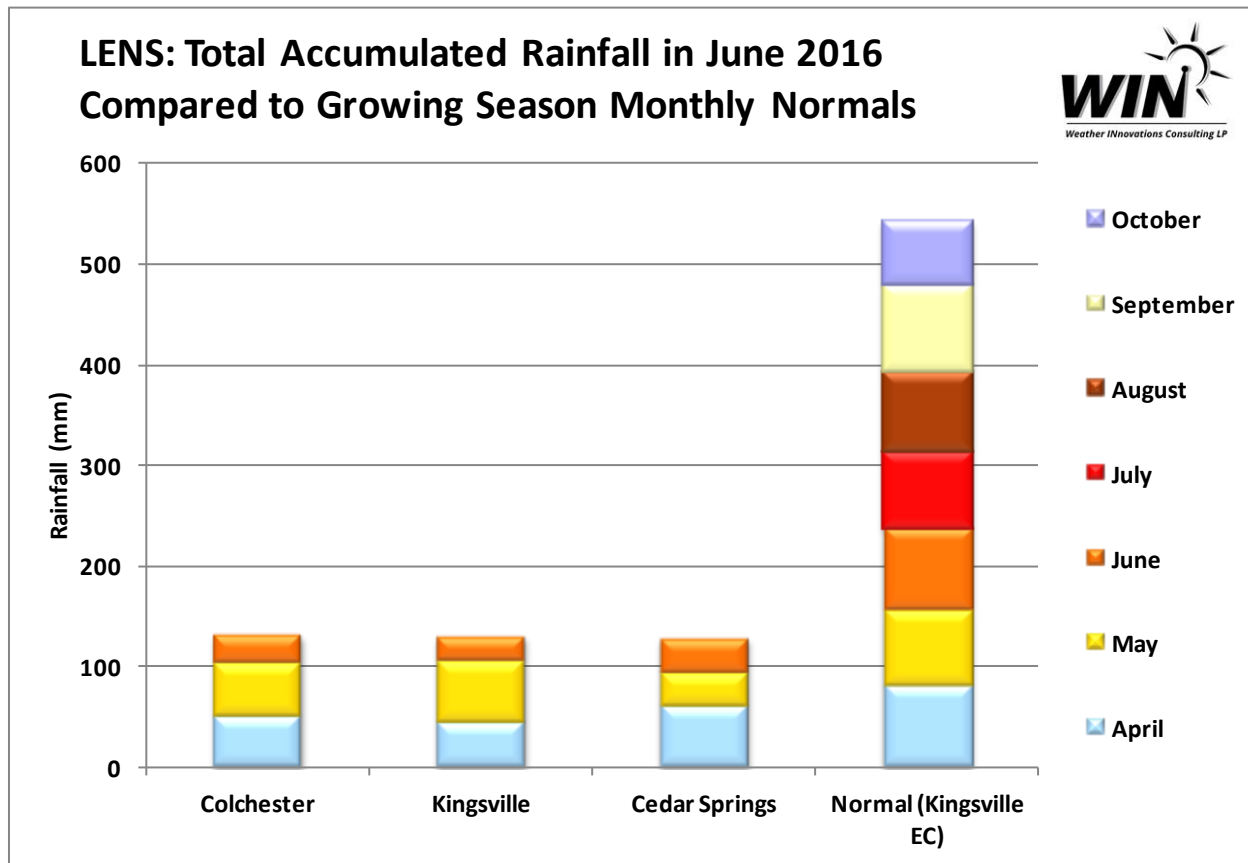


Figure 4: Rainfall
