



September 2016:

September daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Overnight low temperatures were near to above normal across most of the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for September. The growing degree day accumulation is above both 2014 and 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 66 % of normal precipitation in September while Niagara East received 58 % of normal precipitation. Up to 28 mm of rainfall fell on September 28.

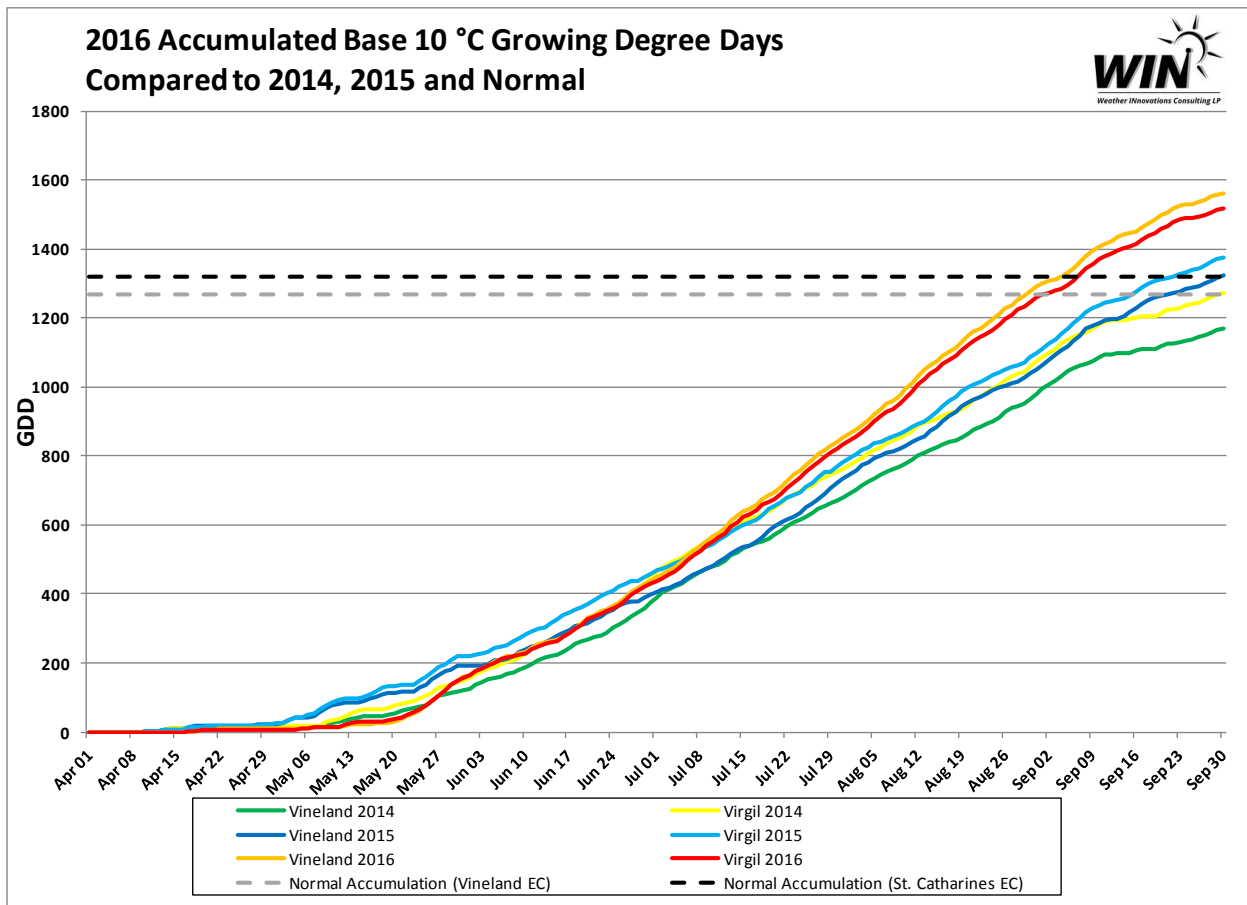


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

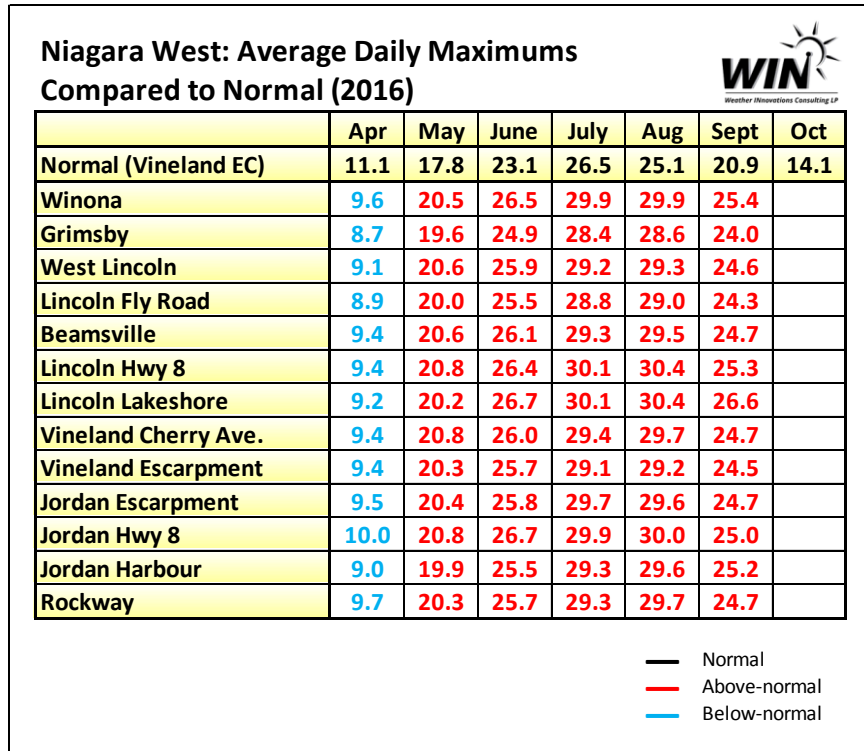


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

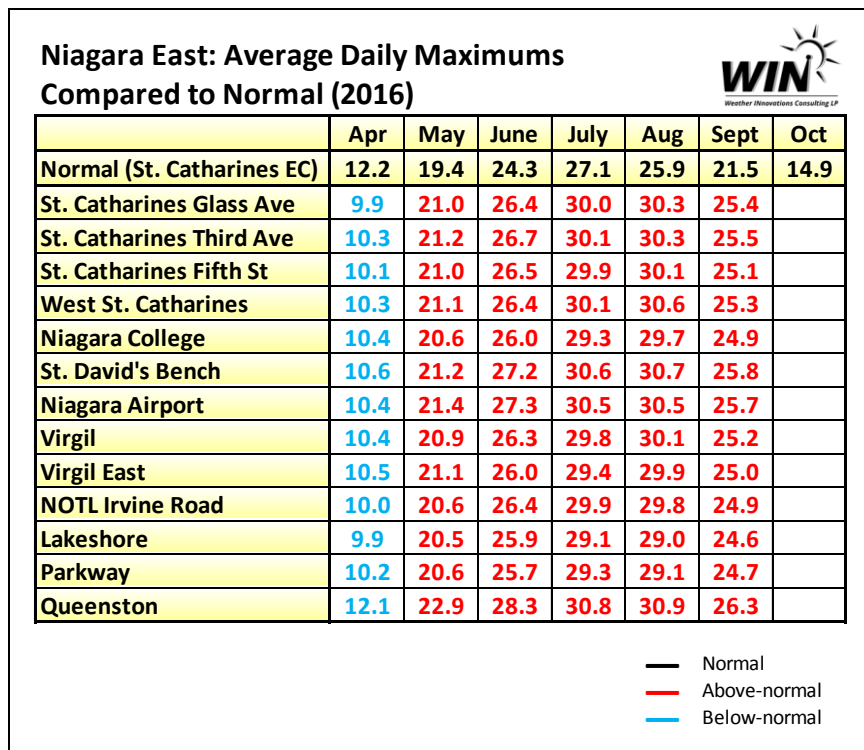


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

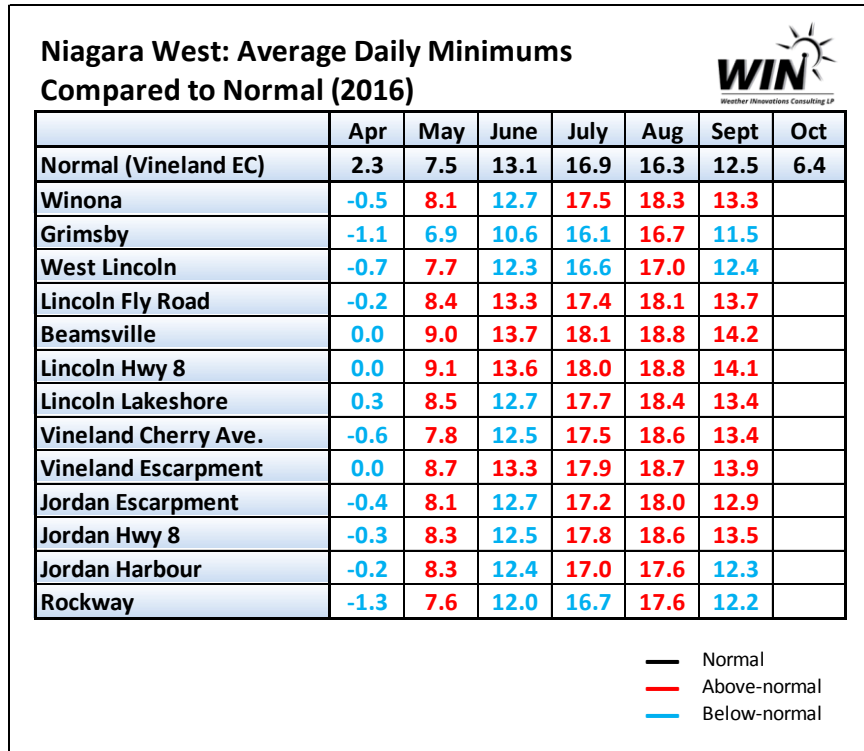


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

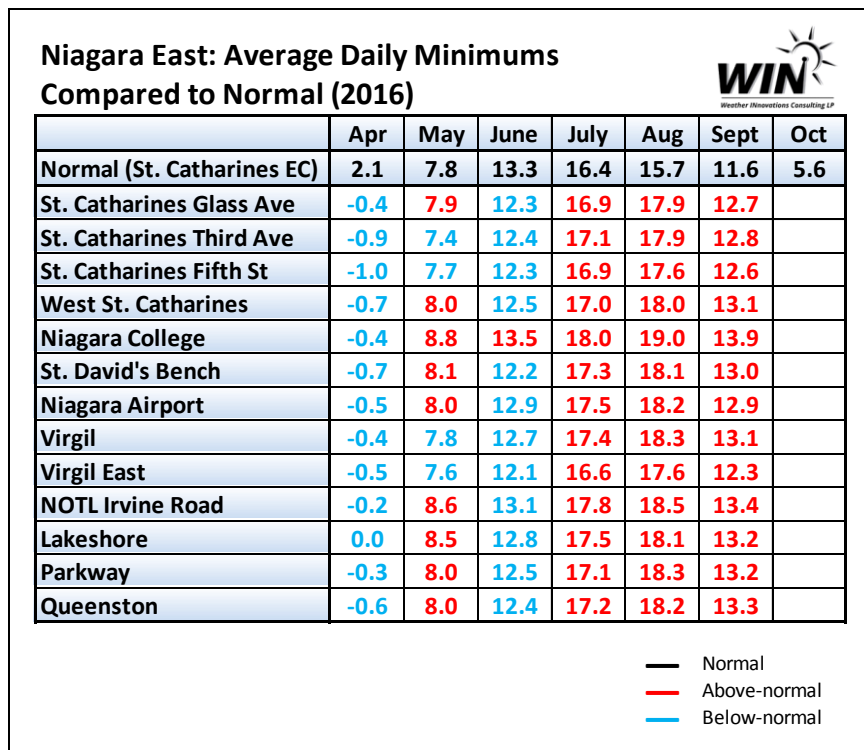


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

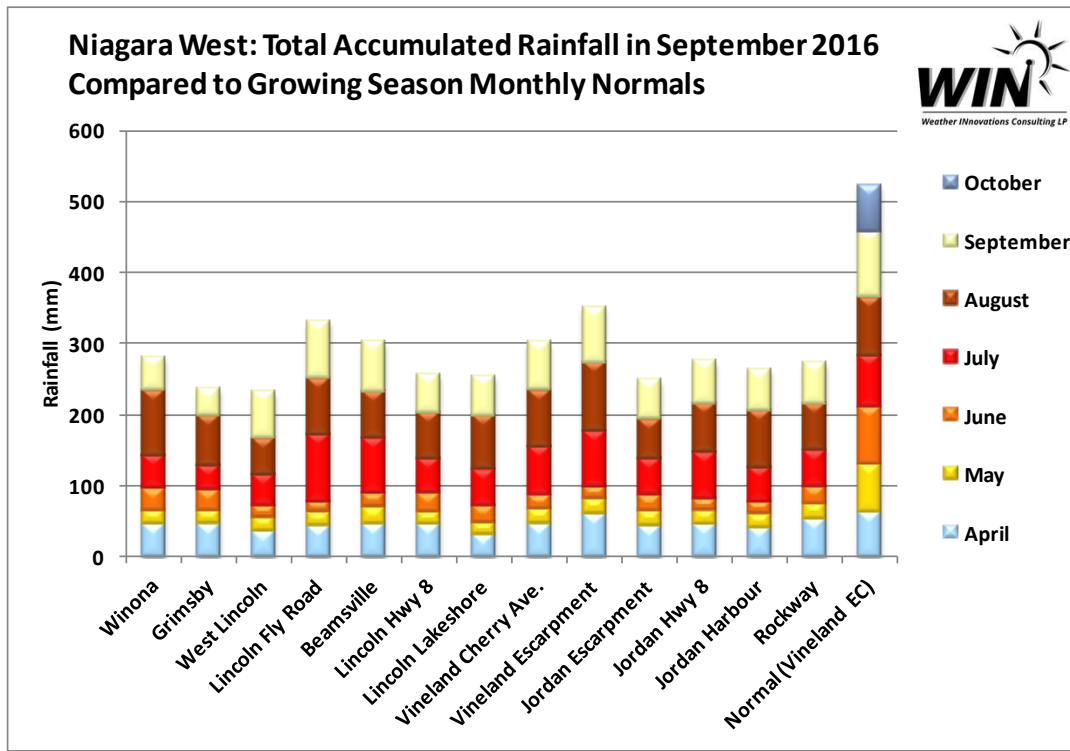


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

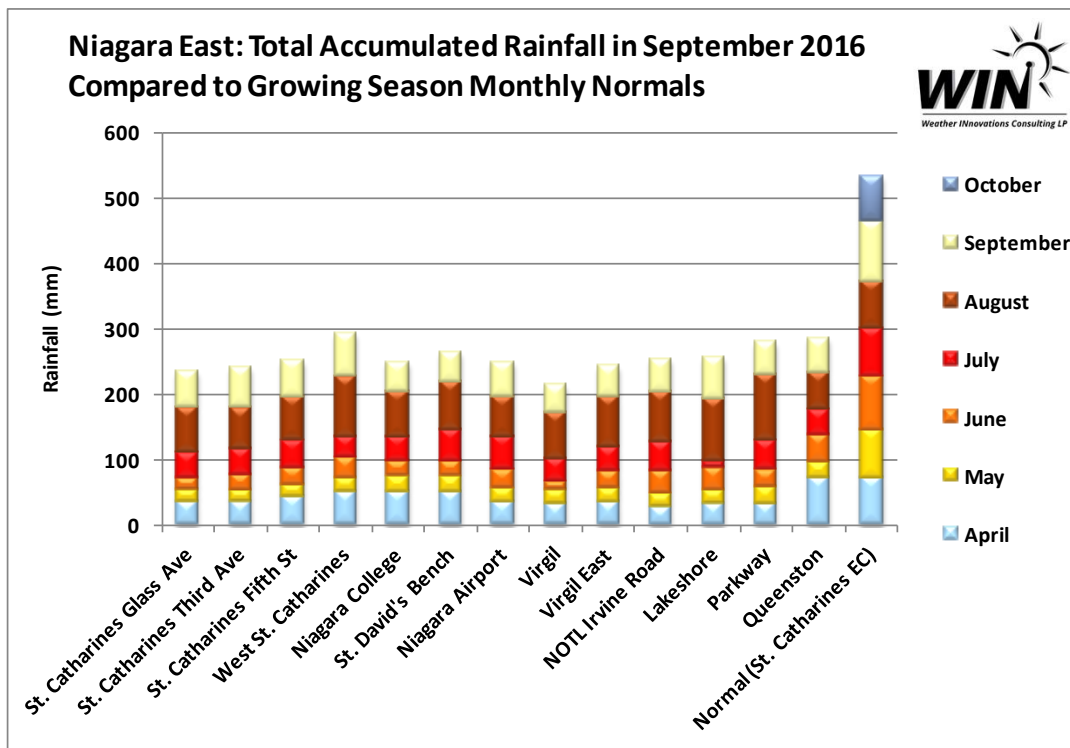


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
