



September 2014:

Daytime high temperatures climbed to above normal values across Niagara. Overnight low temperatures remained below normal. Accordingly, September accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days remained below normal. Seasonal growing degree day accumulation also remained below normal and below 2012 and 2013 values. September rainfall remained below normal. Average rainfall across Niagara West was 69 % of normal and average rainfall across Niagara East was 64 % of normal.

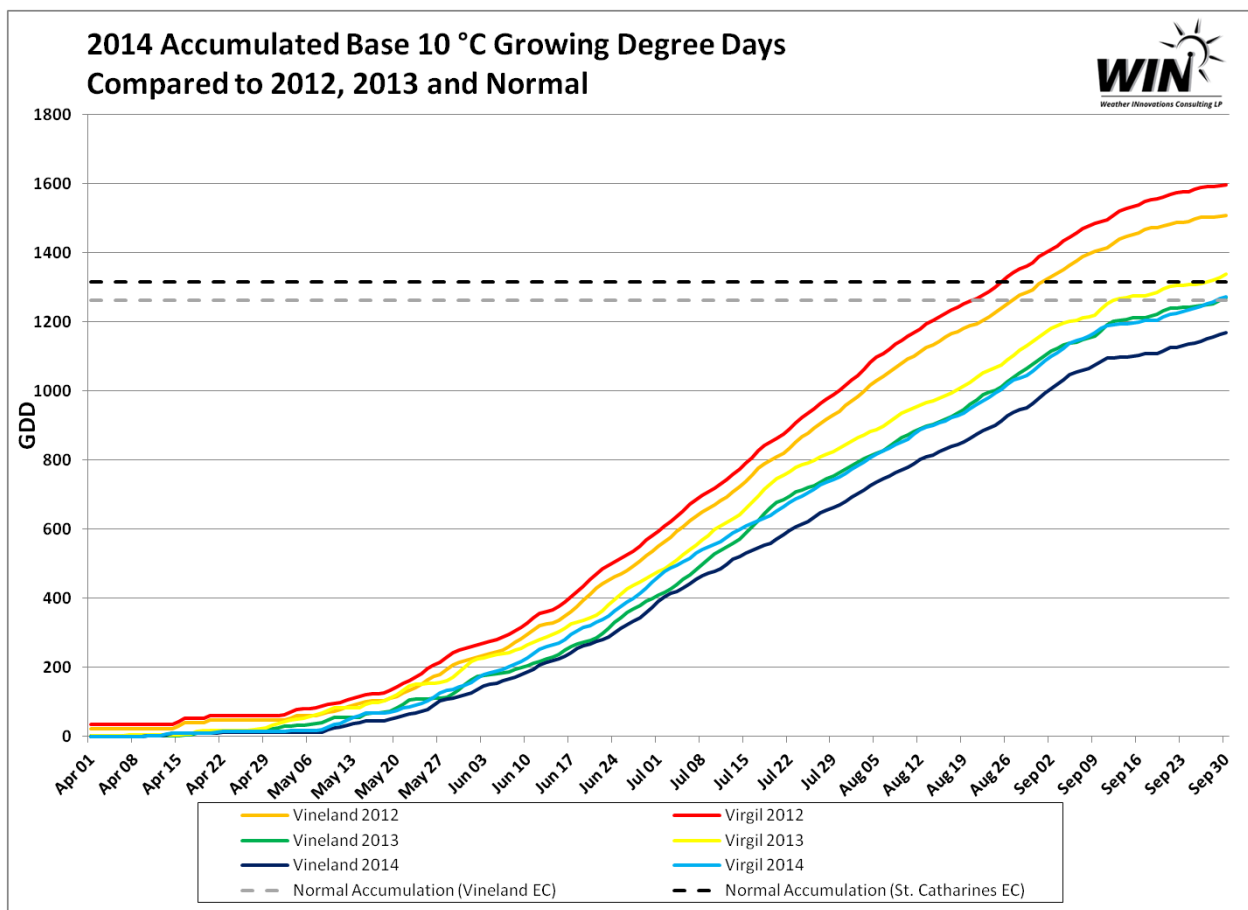


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

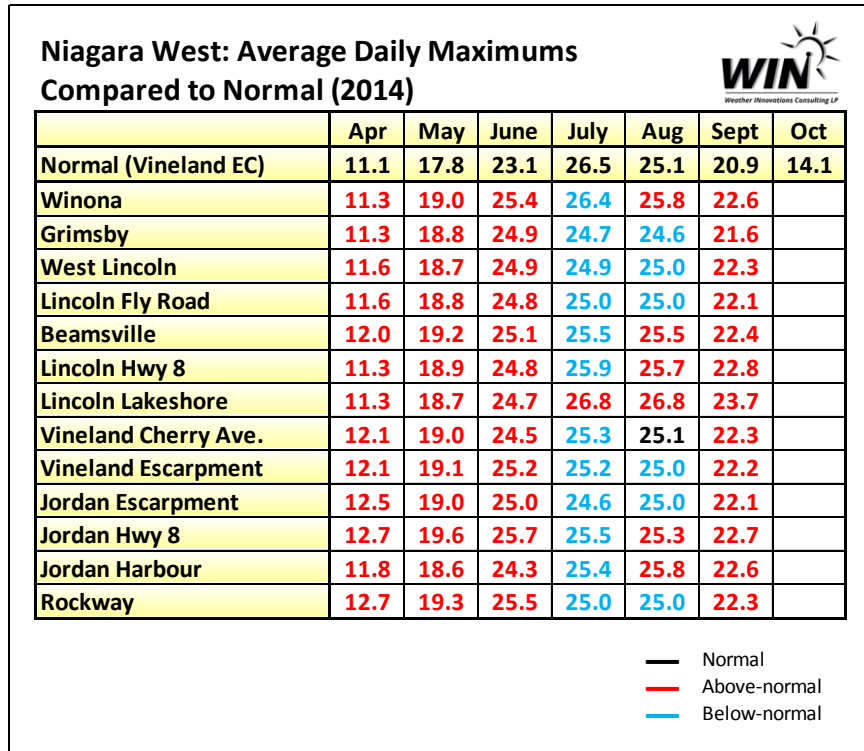


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

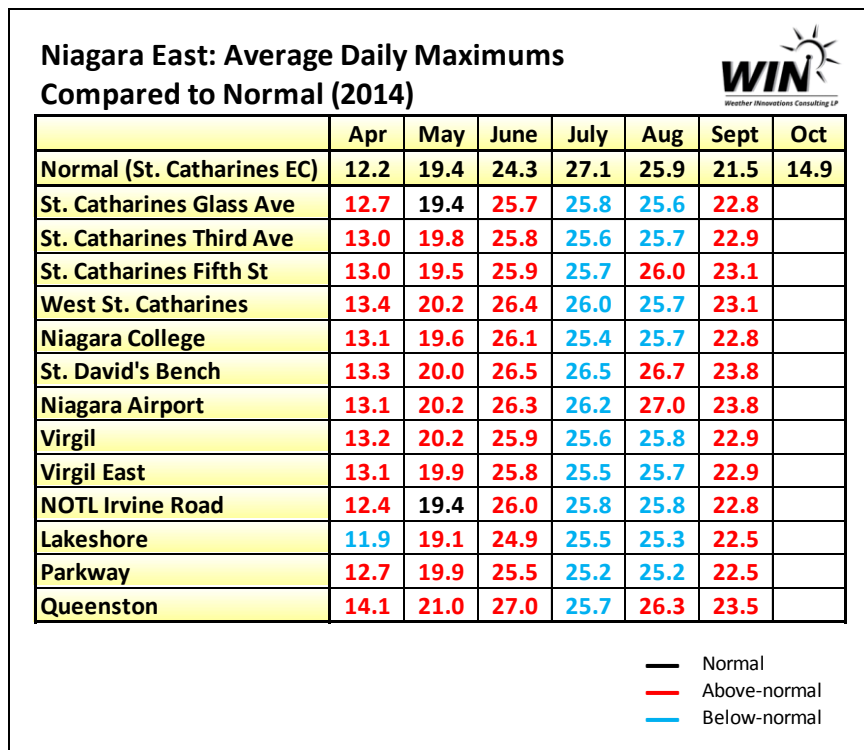


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

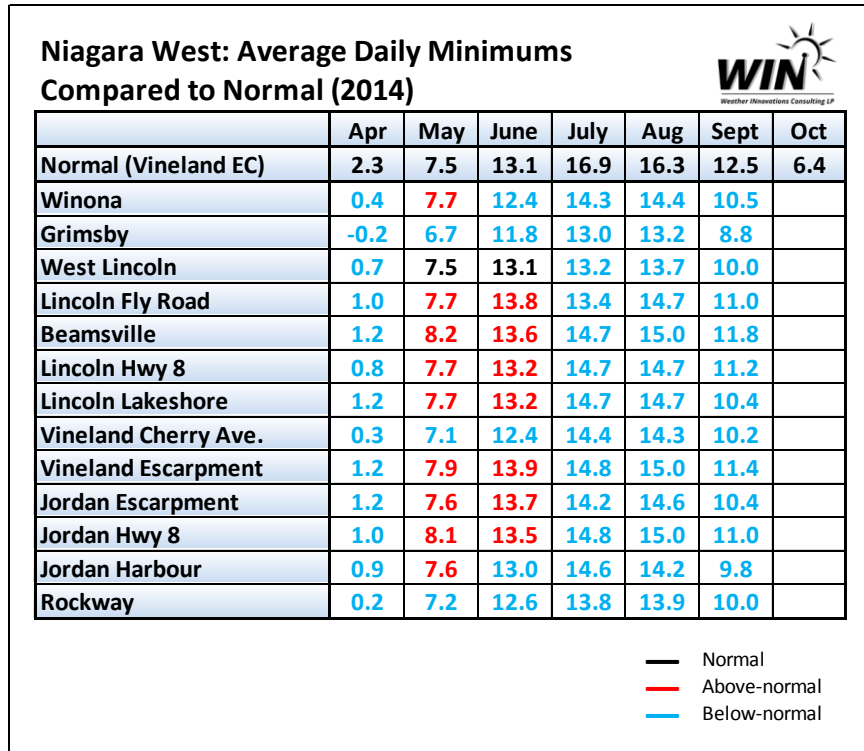


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

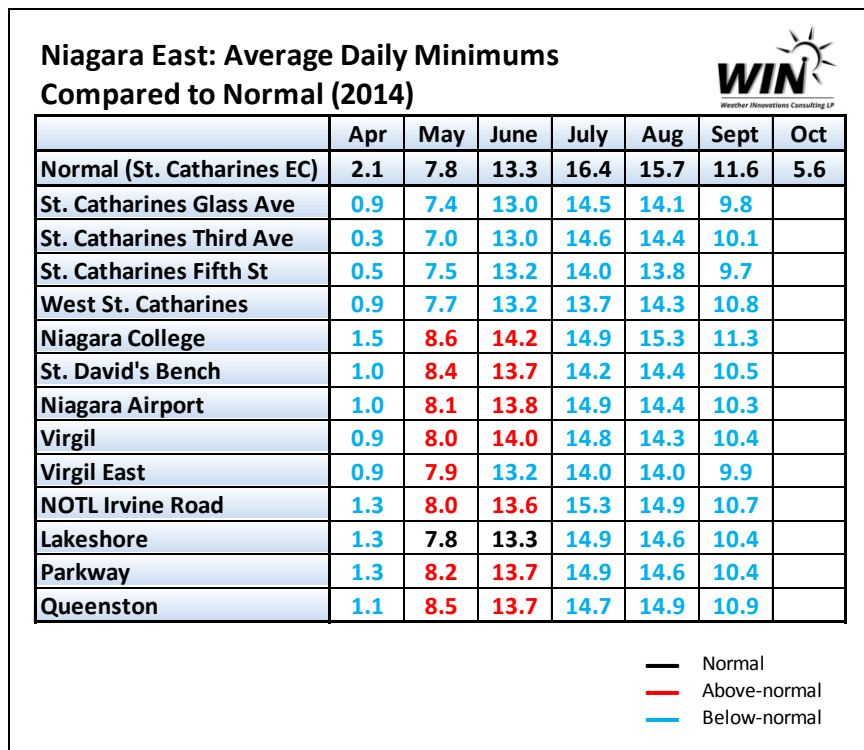


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

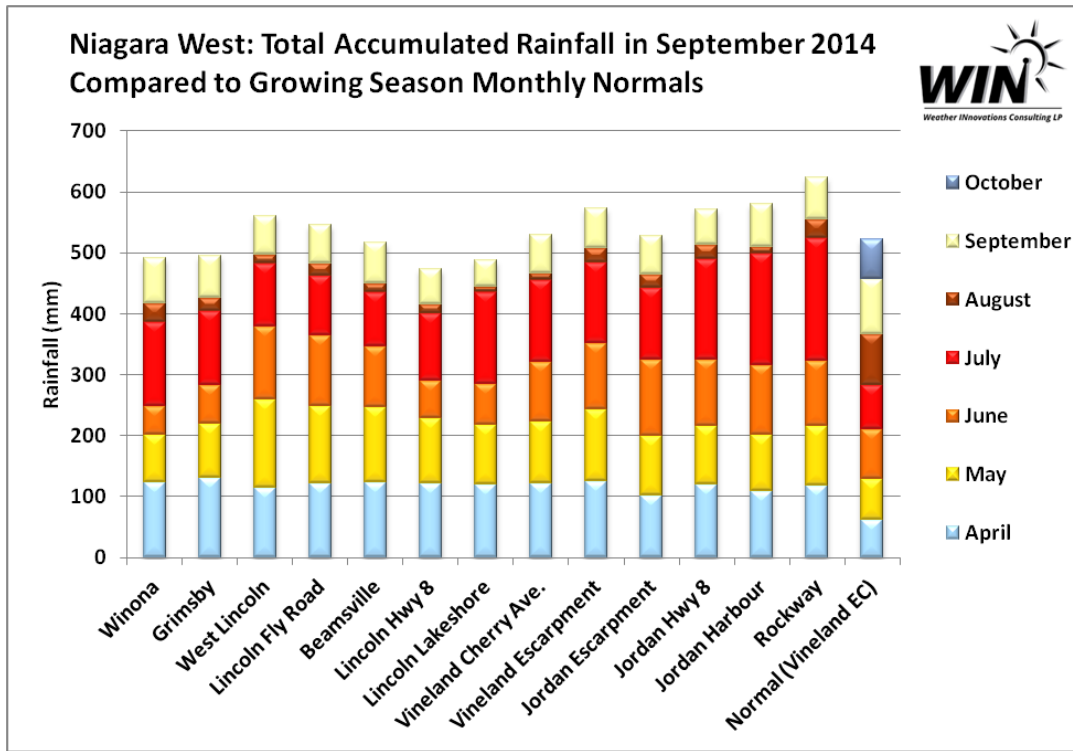


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

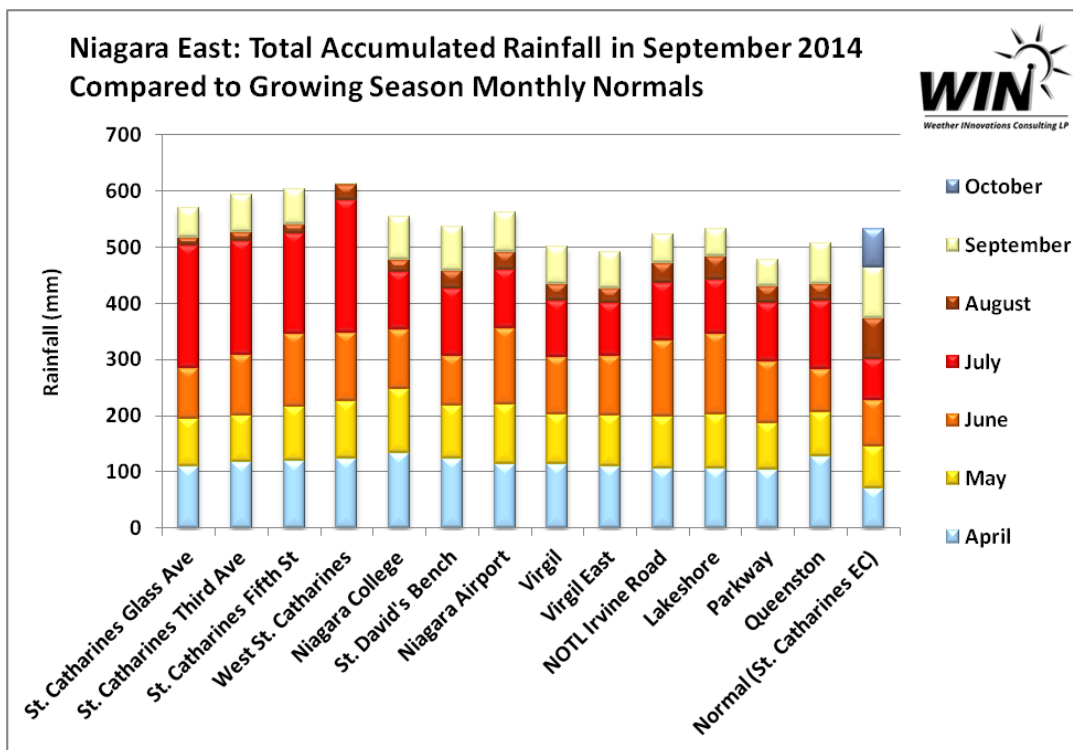


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
