



May 2017:

In May, both daytime high and overnight low temperatures were below normal. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for May. Accumulated growing degree days were below 2016 and 2016 values across the appellation. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 300 % of normal for May. Up to 91 mm of rain was recorded over the three day period of May 4 through 6.

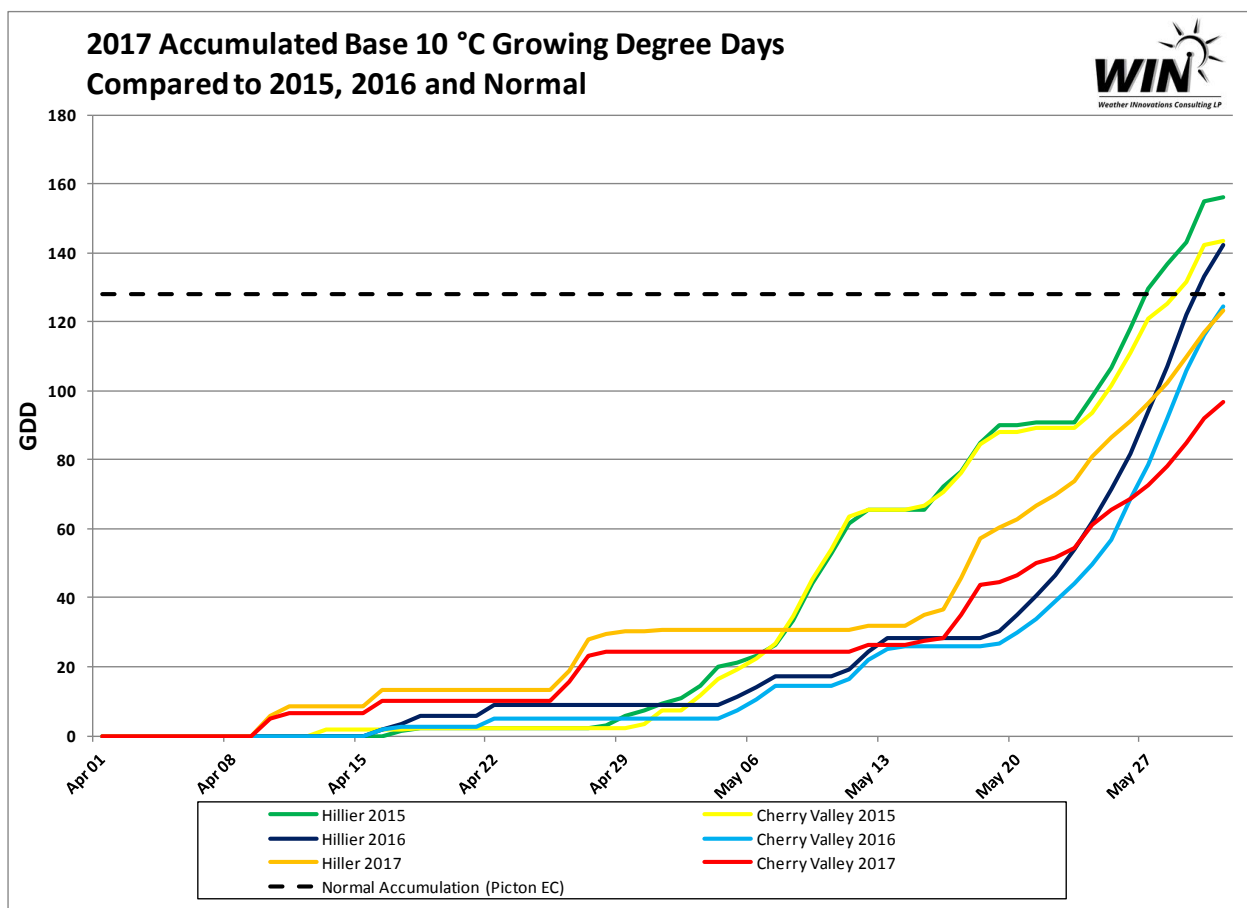


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

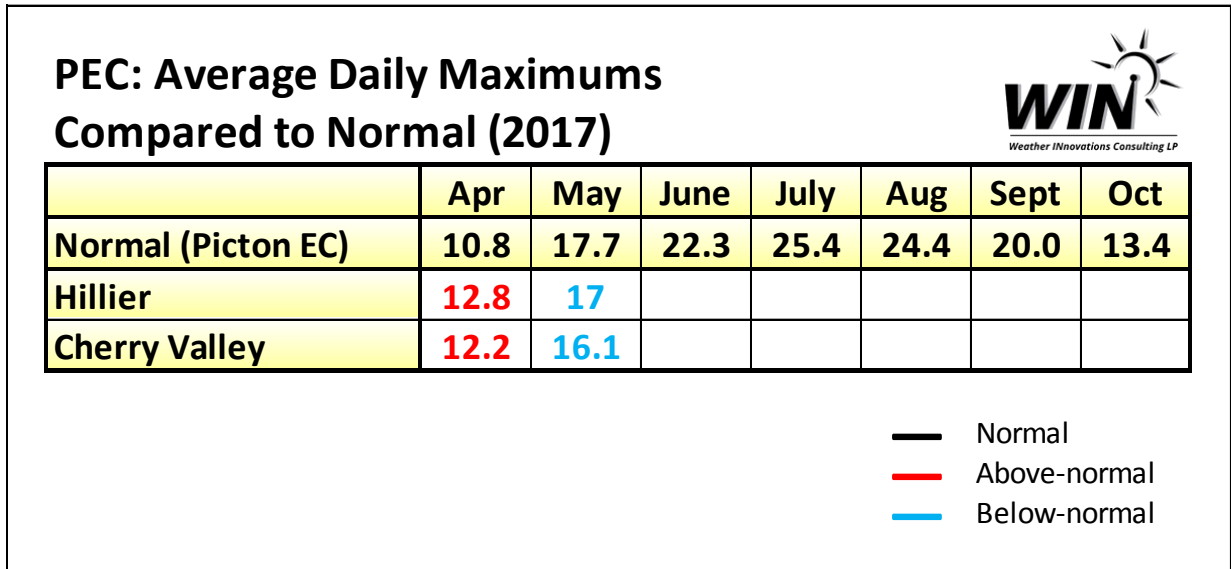


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

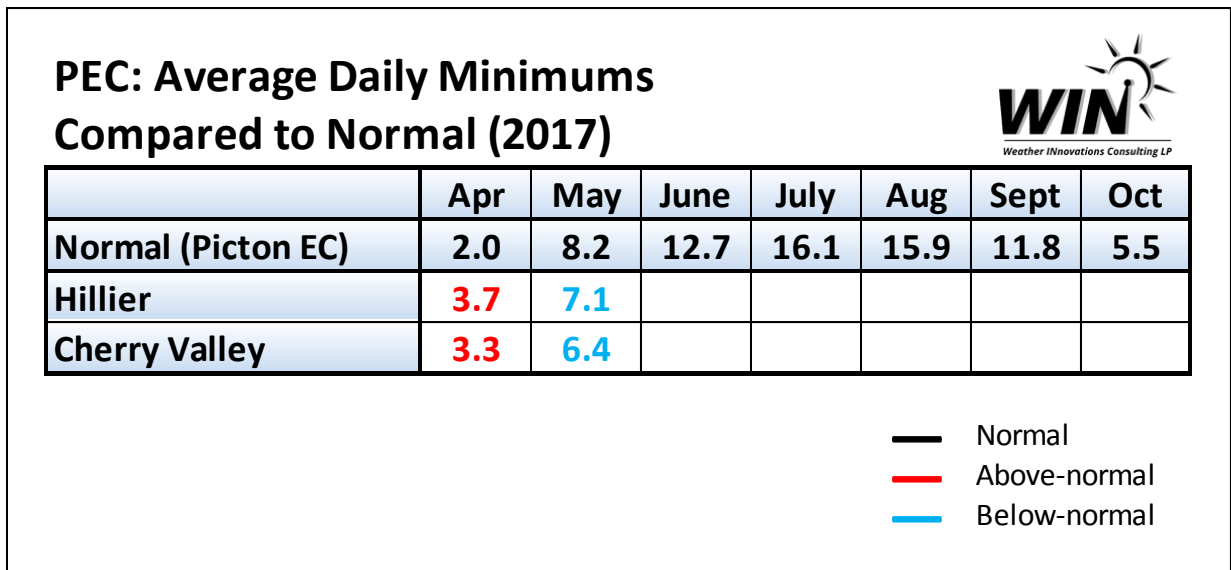


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

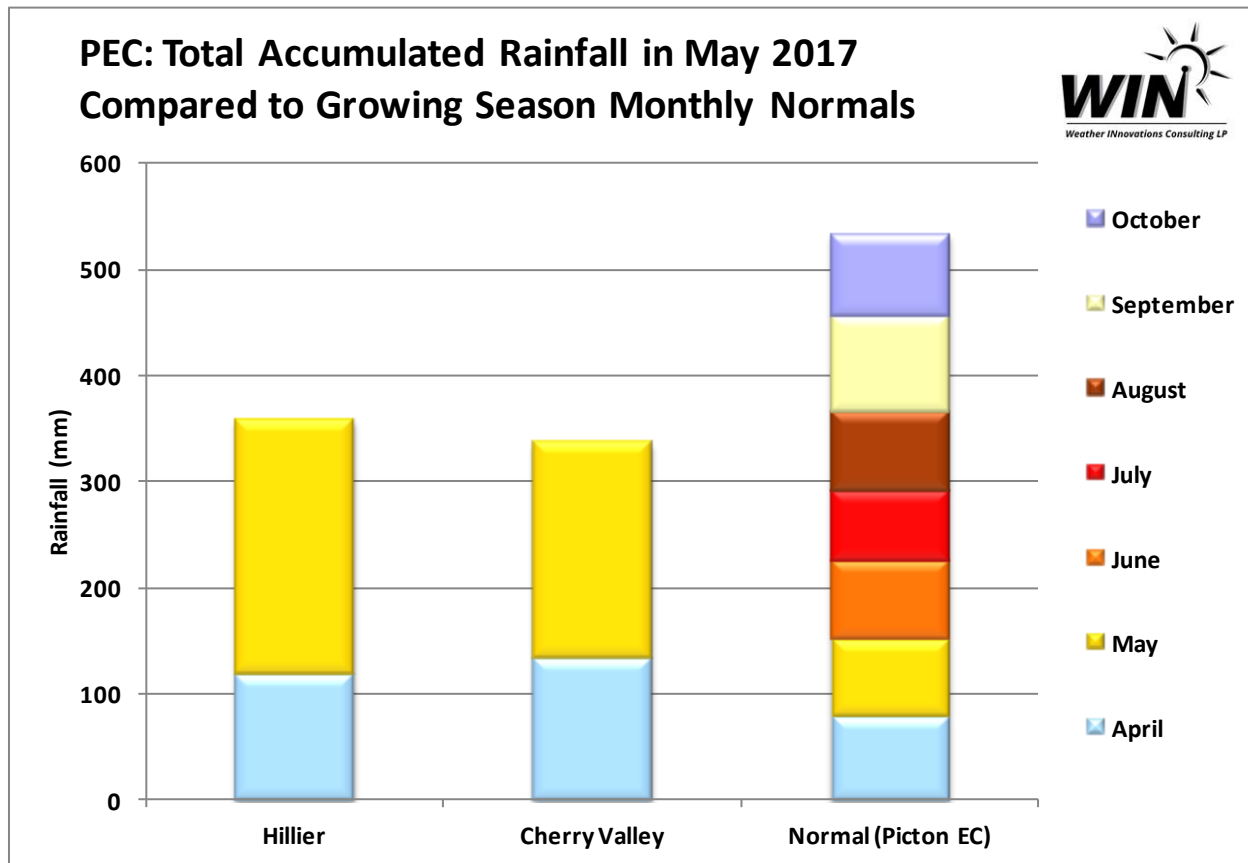


Figure 4: Rainfall
