



September 2016:

In September, daytime highs averaged above normal while overnight lows averaged at or slightly above normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for September. Accumulated growing degree days were above both 2014 and 2015. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 93 % of normal for September. The majority of rainfall occurred during September 7-11. Up to 83 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation during this five day period.

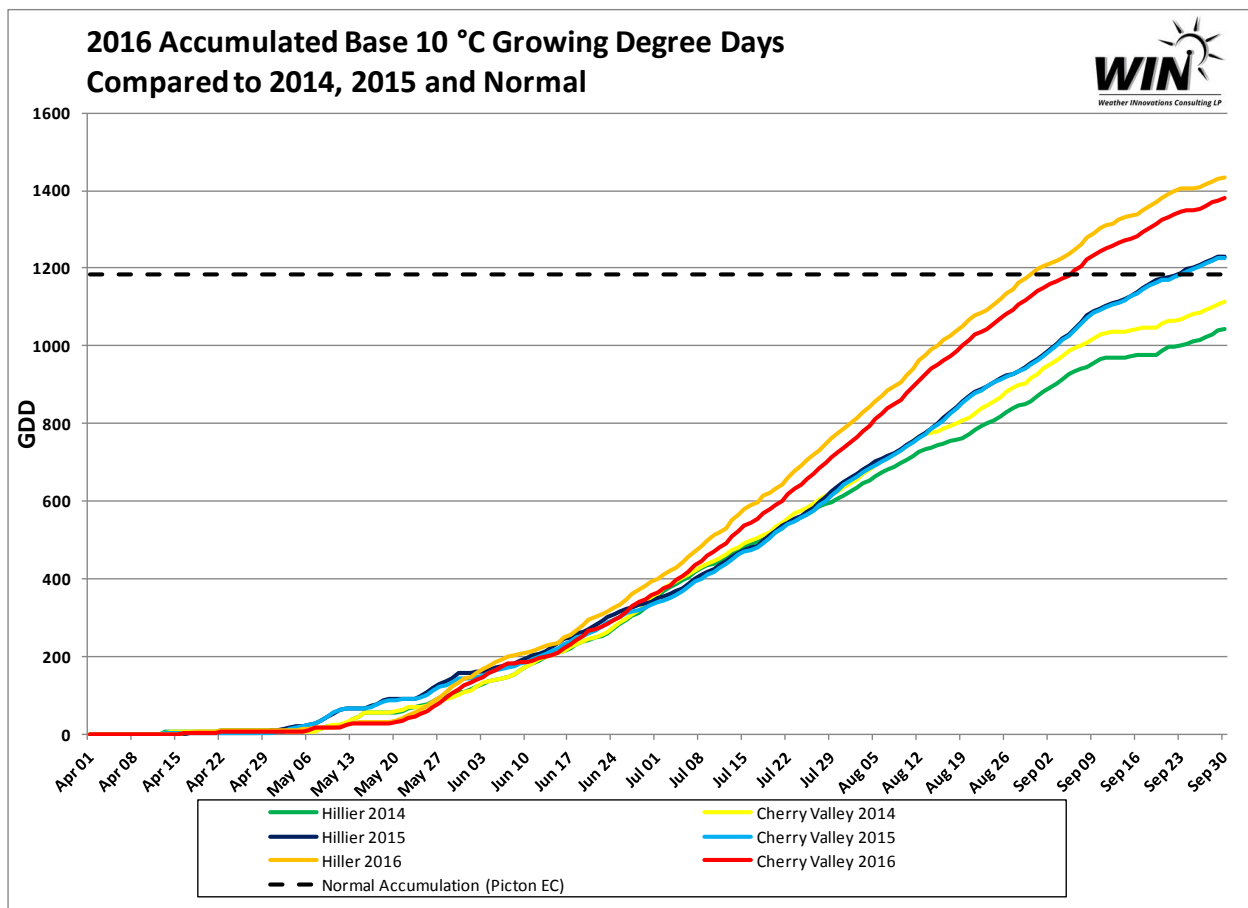


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

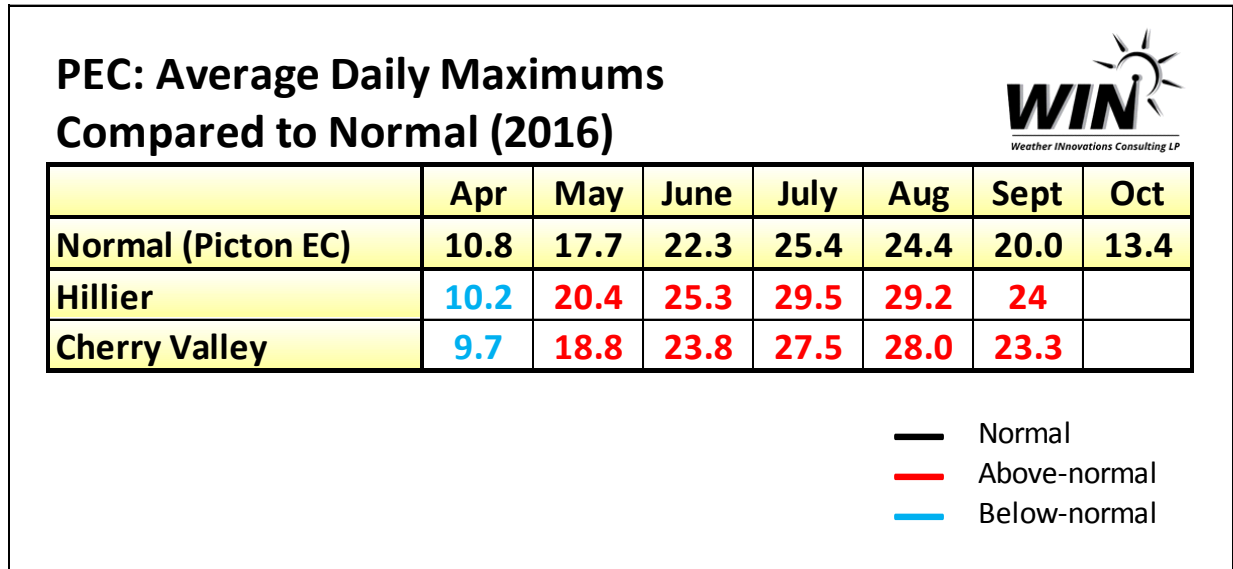


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

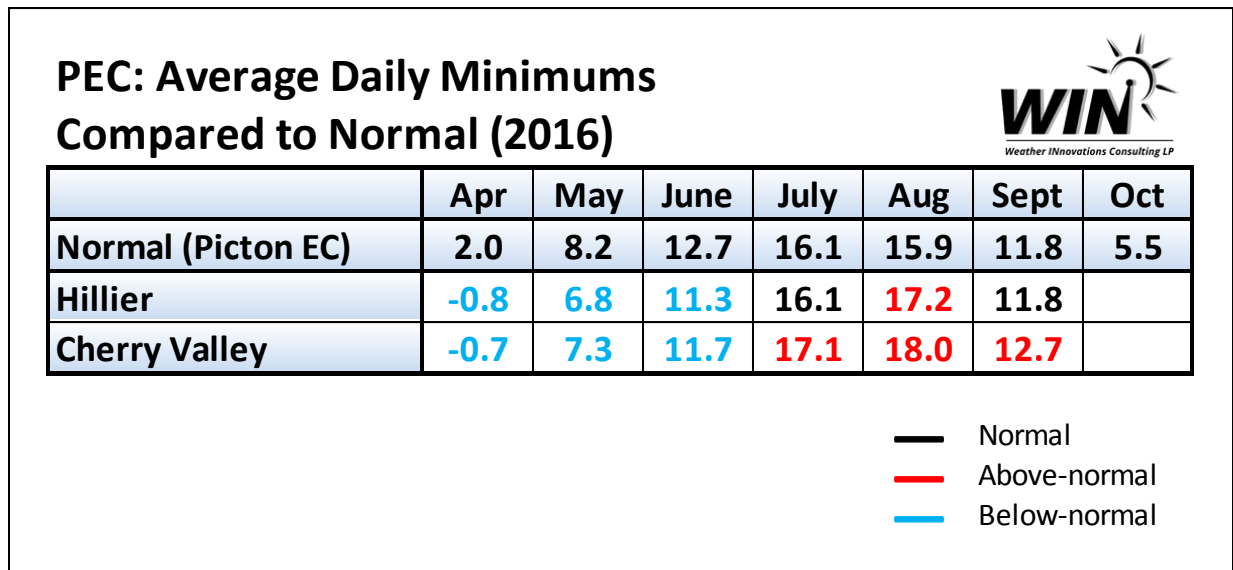


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

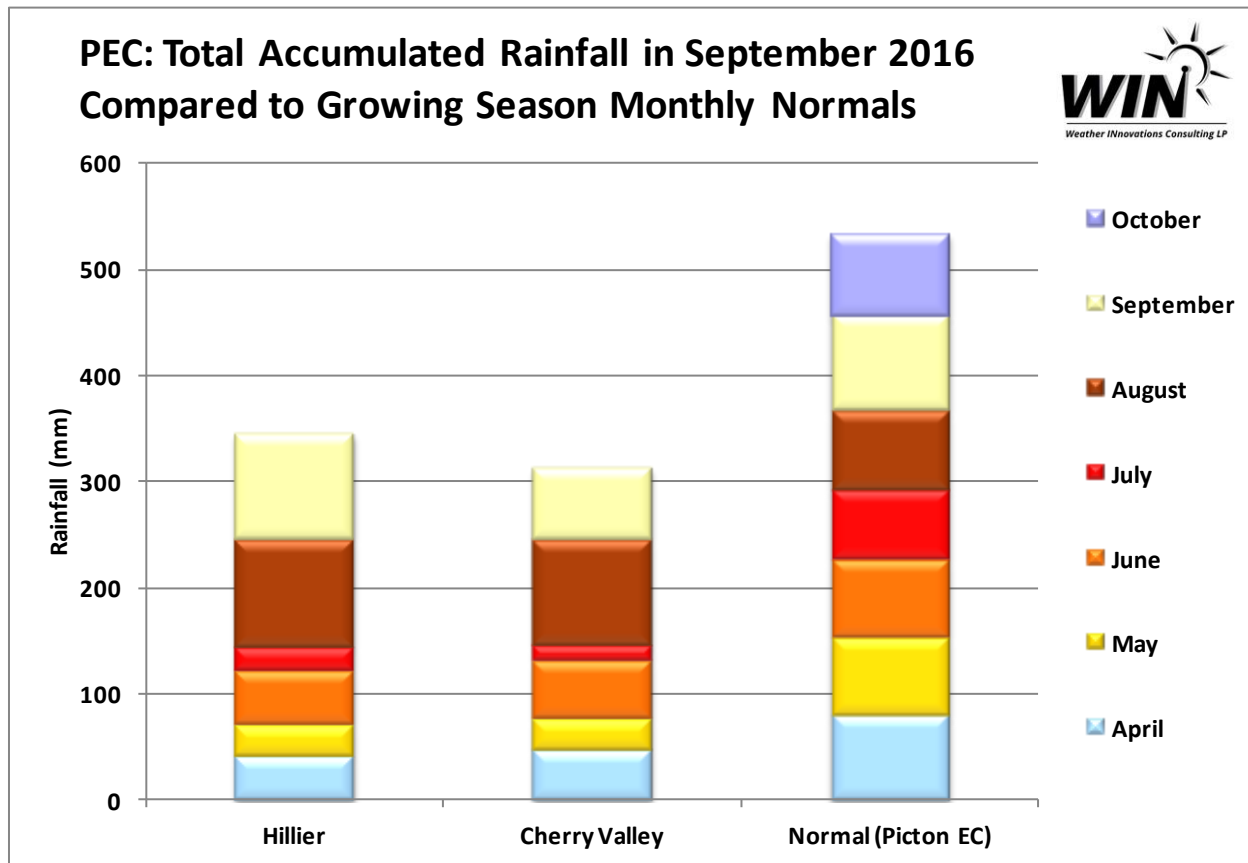


Figure 4: Rainfall
