



September 2017:

In September, daytime highs averaged above normal while overnight lows averaged below or near normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for September. Accumulated growing degree days were below both 2016 and 2015. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 55 % of normal for September. The majority of rainfall occurred during September 3-4. Up to 27 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation during this two day period.

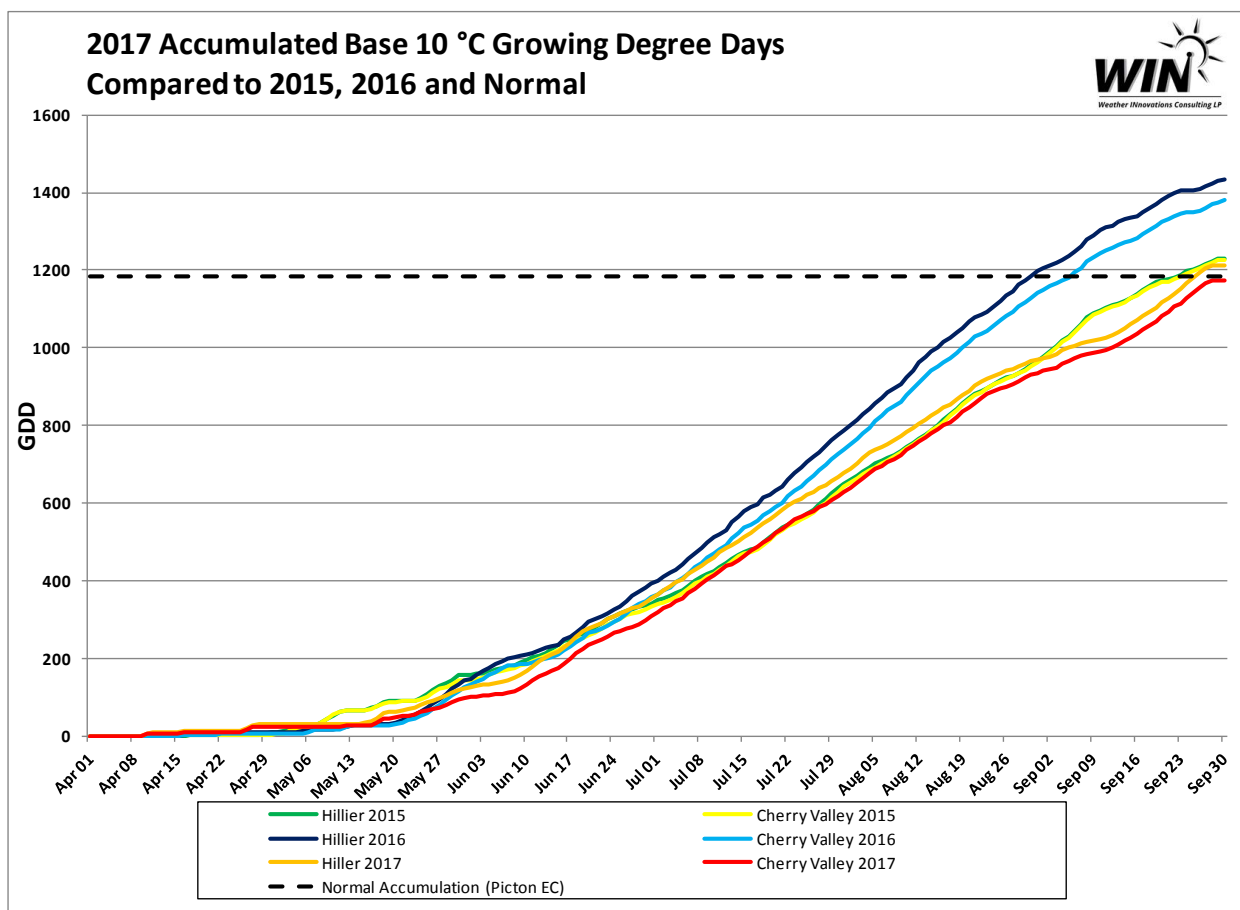


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

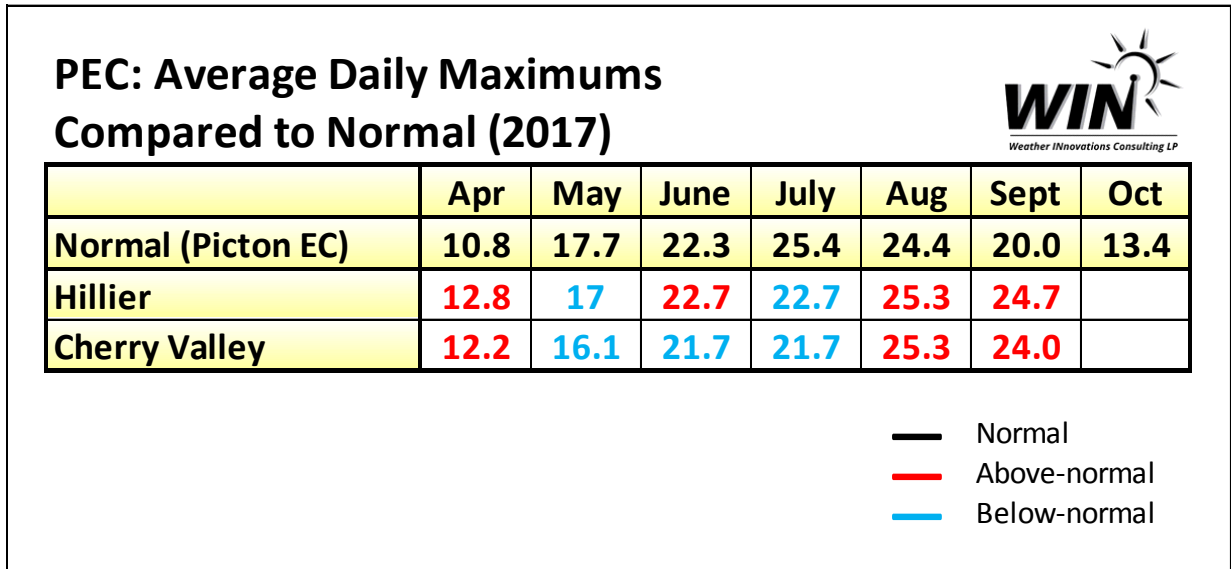


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

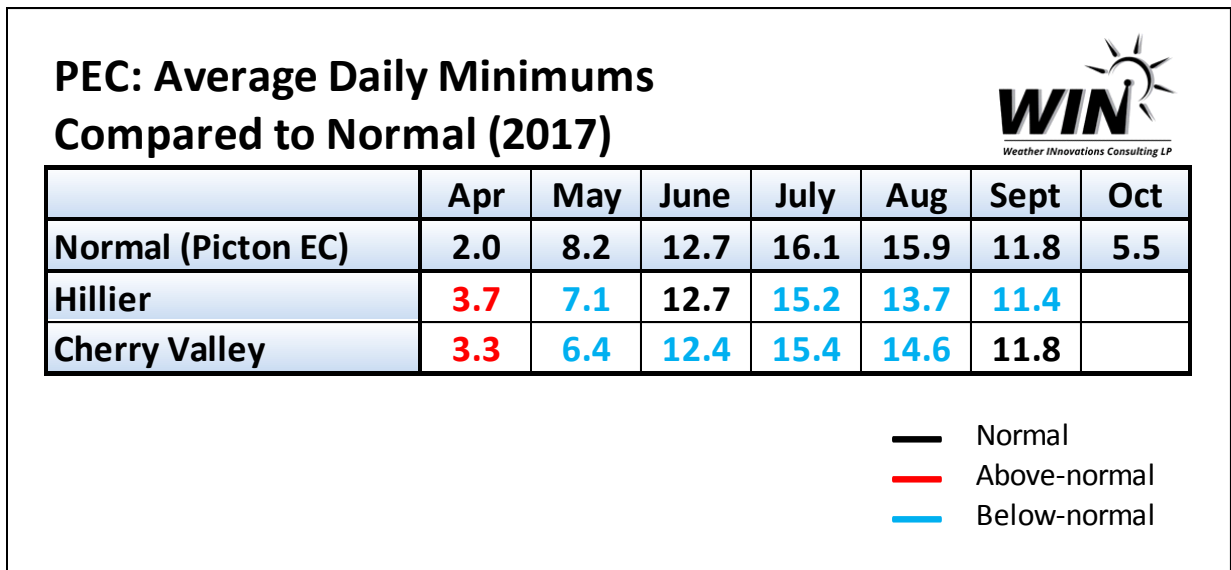


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

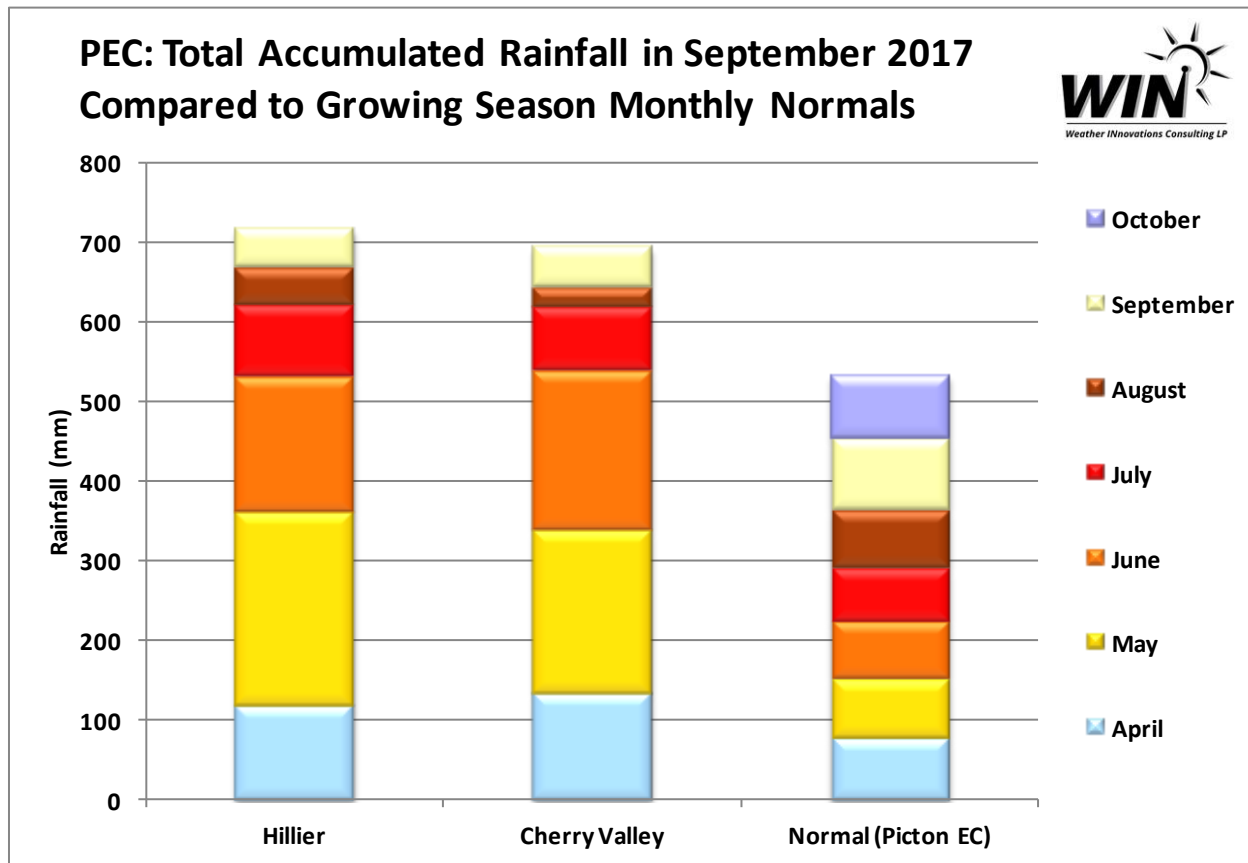


Figure 4: Rainfall
