



September 2015:

September daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. As a result, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for September. Accumulated growing degree days were similar to 2013 values at Cherry Valley and above 2013 values at Hillier. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 118 % of normal for September. The appellation received up to 56 mm of rain over September 12-13 and up to 44 mm of rain over September 28-30.

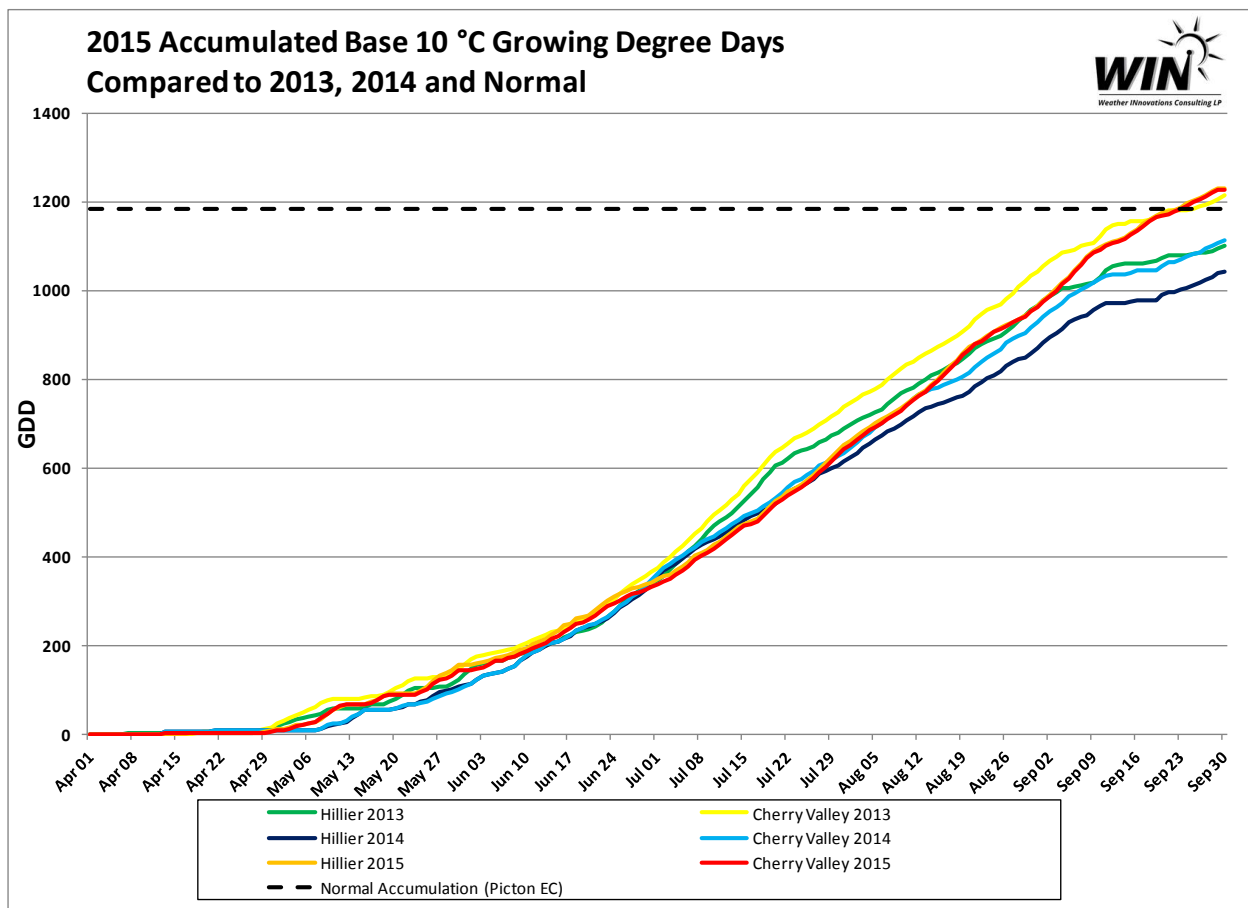


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

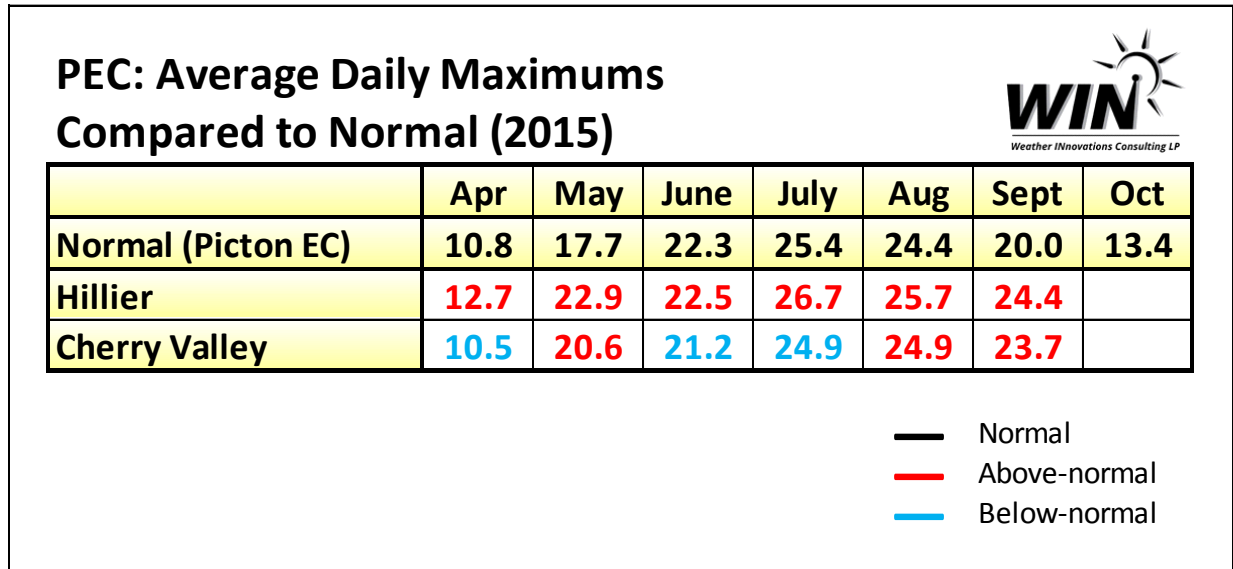


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

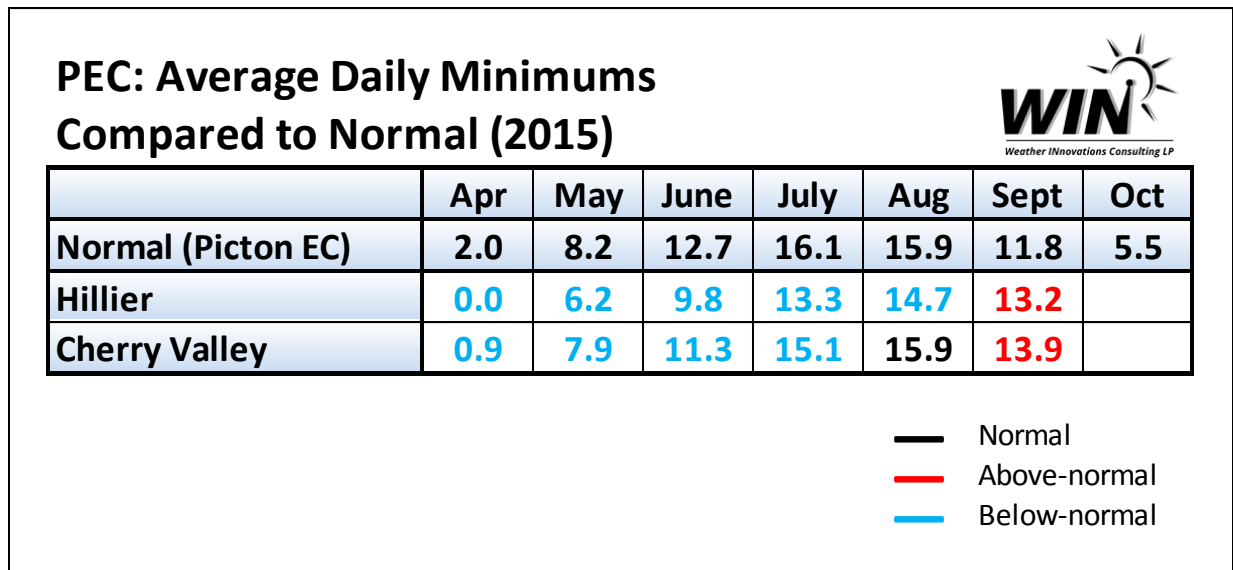


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

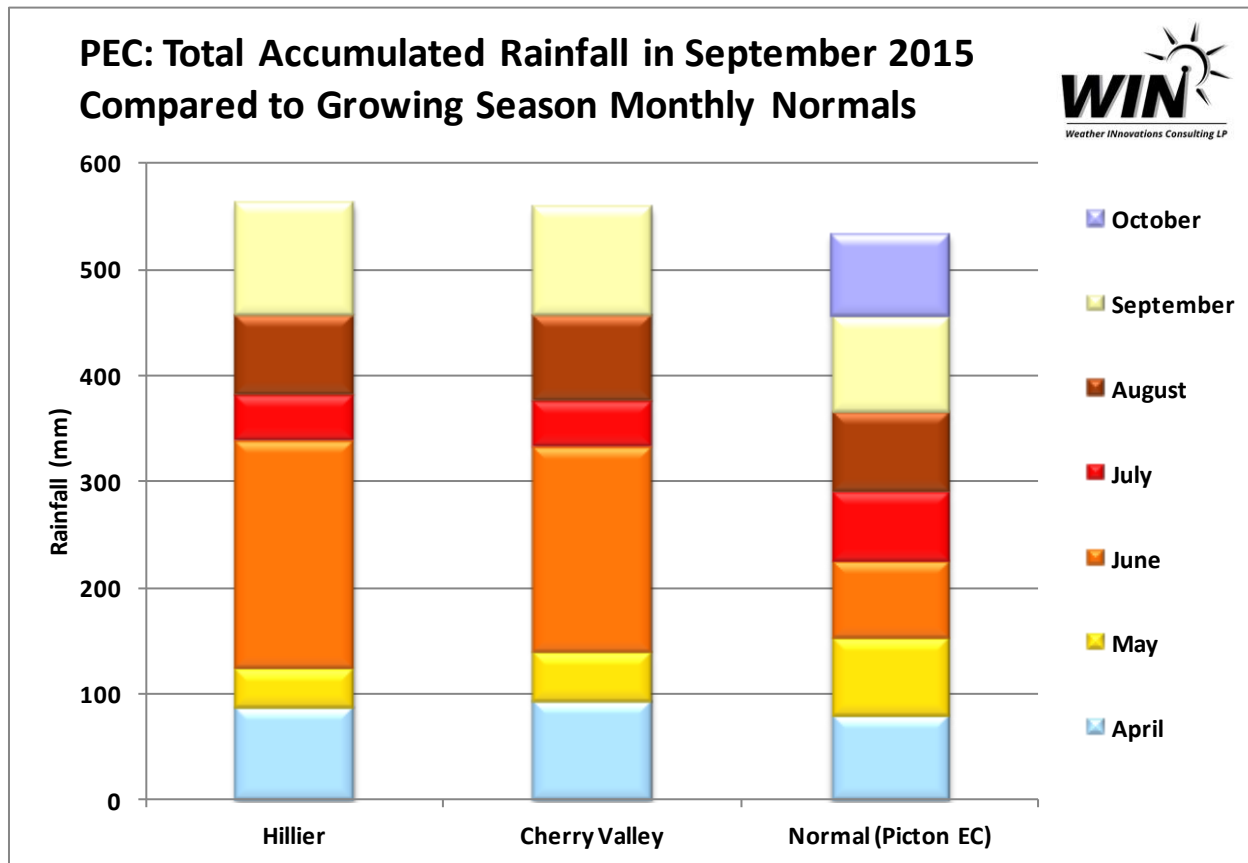


Figure 4: Rainfall
